Seamless Back-Office Integration for Simultaneous DOCSIS and PON Network Management

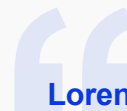
Antietam Broadband was founded in 1966 and is owned by Schurz Communications, Inc. Antietam improves the quality of life for the communities they serve with a comprehensive range of services to 40,000 residential and business customers in Hagerstown and Washington County, Maryland.

Antietam recently deployed a targeted fiber network in response to competitive threats. With Calix, Antietam deployed XGS PON in just a month, which mitigated share loss. Key drivers of this rapid deployment were a fast Calix response to deploy the equipment, and Antietam's ability to seamlessly integrate their new PON network with their existing DOCSIS back-office systems.

Even with targeted PON deployments, most of Antietam's subscribers are DOCSIS-served and they've invested significantly in their DOCSIS back-office systems. Antietam will continue to manage both DOCSIS and fiber networks for years to come. They needed a solution to support the simultaneous management of both DOCSIS and FTTH systems.

THE SOLUTION

Antietam offers fully Managed Wi-Fi to subscribers served by both HFC and PON networks. For DOCSIS-served subscribers, Antietam deploys GigaSpire BLAST units behind cable modems already in place. This ensures all subscribers have the same superior Wi-Fi experience and provides Antietam proactive visibility into their entire network—both DOCSIS and fiber—via Calix Support Cloud.

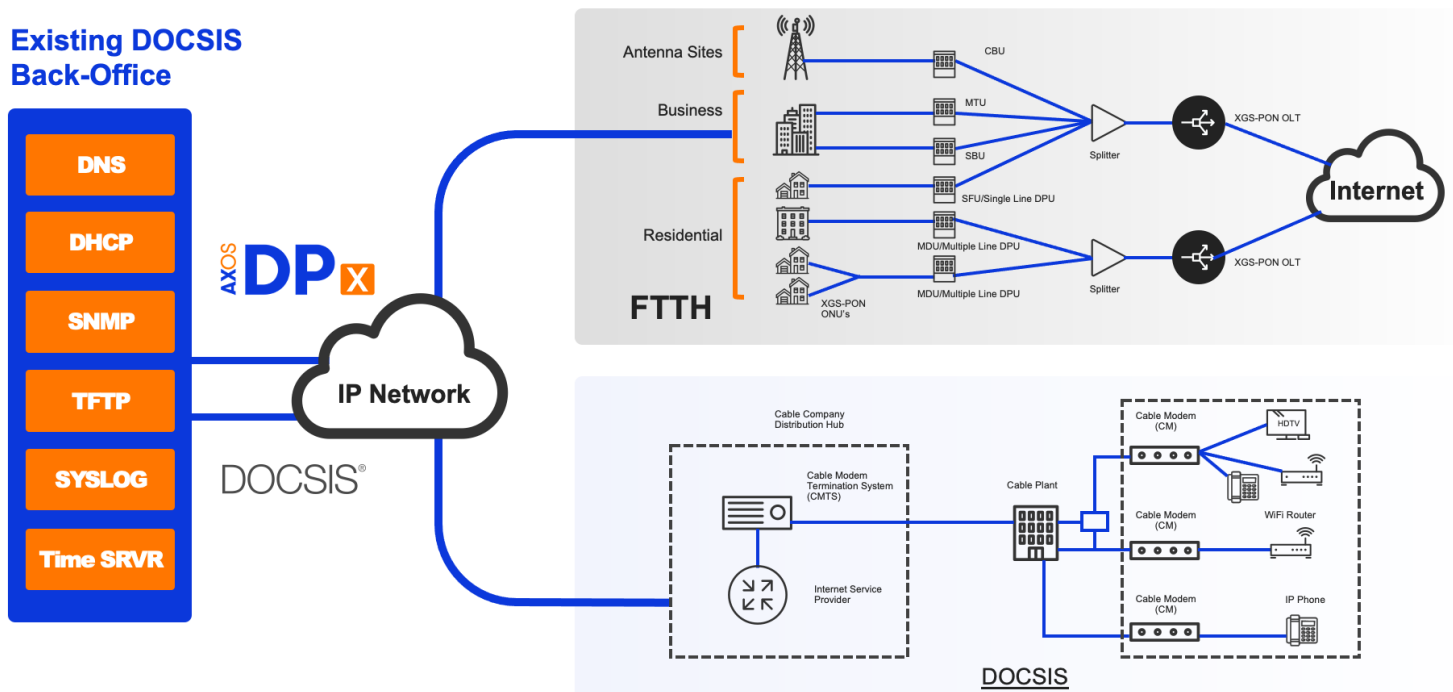

With Calix Support Cloud, Antietam teams can quickly and proactively identify and address any problems using real-time insights. With end-to-end network visibility, the Antietam team can resolve most issues remotely without needing to dispatch a technician. Calix's DOCSIS Provisioning Connector software (DPx) enables Antietam to seamlessly operate both XGS-PON and HFC access networks and deliver Managed Wi-Fi and Support Cloud over both networks.

DPx is a DOCSIS-PON back-office integration solution, allowing operators to provision and monitor PON access networks using the same OSS platform as their existing DOCSIS network. An operator can retain their existing operational procedures and systems, eliminating the need to retrain provisioning and customer support personnel.

DPx enables seamless integration with an operator's existing DOCSIS OSS. DPx allows the ONT to look like a Virtual Cable Modem, and the OLT to look like a virtual CMTS. The operator can begin deploying FTTH right away as greenfield or brownfield and transition from DOCSIS in the access network to PON at whatever speed makes sense. Or the operator could maintain both systems going forward.
